Let me give you example of “walking alone” and “*Standing for God.*” May these examples challenge us to never be shamed of our stand for Christ.

As his life and leadership were coming to a close, Joshua challenged his people to determine whom they would serve. Then he firmly states, “*But as for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.*” (Joshua 24:15)

Captives in a strange and idolatrous country, Daniel and his three friends responded to the king, “*We want you to know, your majesty that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up.*” (Daniel 3:18)

When pressured to recant his writings and teachings, Martin Luther steadfastly stated, “*I cannot and will not recant anything, for to go against conscience is neither right nor safe. Here I stand; I can do no other, so help me God, Amen.*”

Patrick Henry stated these words in the birth pangs of our nation, “*Is life so dear, or peace so sweet, as to be purchased at the price of chains and slavery? Forbid it almighty God: I know not what courses others may take, but as for me, give me liberty or give me death!*”





We could mention many others. Daniel prayed alone, even though he was thrown into the Lion’s den. Elijah stood alone for God on Mount Carmel against the false prophets of Baal. Jeremiah prophesied and wept alone. Jesus suffered and died alone.

Note Carefully:

1. It not only takes courage to stand alone, it takes the conviction you are in the right.
2. It is better to walk alone than to walk with the crowd that is going in the wrong direction.
3. When you walk alone, you may feel lonely and even lost, but remember God knows exactly where you are.

If you are standing for God, You are never alone!

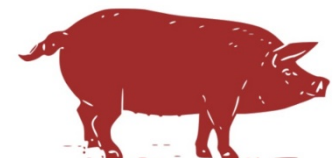

FRUIT LADYBUGS

Get creative in the kitchen with this sweet springtime snack.

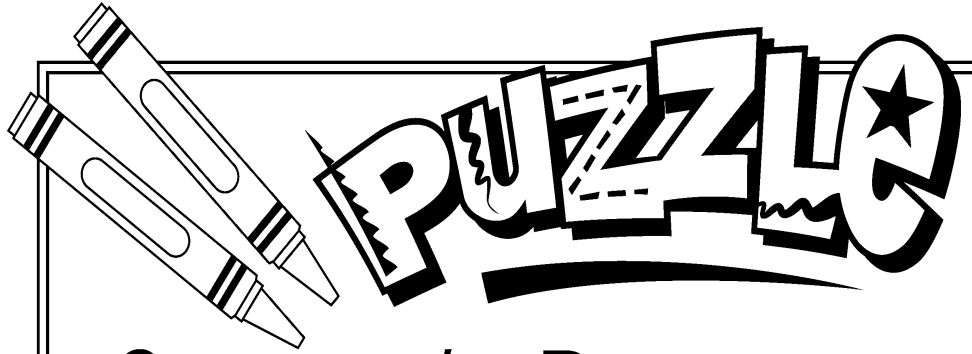
What you need:

- Strawberries (washed)
- Knife
- Plate or wax paper
- ½ cup melted chocolate chips
- Zippered baggie
- Scissors
- Blueberries (washed)
- Adult help



What you do:

1. De-stem the strawberries. Cut in half and then cut a small V atop each half to make the ladybug body. Set them on a plate or wax paper.
2. Place the melted chocolate in a baggie and cut off the tip of a bottom corner.
3. Pipe a dividing line and "spots" on each strawberry. Also use the chocolate to attach a blueberry "head" by the V shape.
4. Pipe chocolate antennas and legs onto ladybugs.
5. Let harden. Enjoy!
